For Dante, the art has always been about the act of glassblowing. Throughout the years, he has continued to refine his designs and push his skills to the limit. His newest series of Leaf forms exemplify this pursuit, with improbable symmetry and striking cane patterns they balance elegantly at heights of up to three and a half feet. We are thrilled to present this new exhibition and invite you to join us in celebrating Dante's extraordinary talent and achievement in glass. Dante Marioni has exhibited extensively throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia with galleries and museums alike. His work is included in the permanent collections of both national and international museums, including the White House Crafts Collection, the Renwick Gallery at the Smithsonian, and the Chrysler Museum.
